- Interact and/ or meet with assigned mentee for 2-4 hours per month. (Included but not limited to social media, face to face interaction, text message, phone calls, or email.)
- Attend two monthly TIP meetings, social event, speaking engagement, or other TIP activity (preferably with your mentee).
- Report mentee interactions to TIP using the online portal outlined in training session.
- Provide TIP with updated driver's license and vehicle insurance information.

Responsibilities

- Develop ongoing mentor relationship with assigned mentee and TIP.
- Act as a professional role model.
- Assist mentee in navigating on campus and off campus resources.
- Help implement and execute ideas that will benefit your assigned mentee and TIP.
